- Mission. 1 ATF to occupy blocking positions within AO SURFERS to interdict enemy withdrawal routes from the South and SW.

- Gen Outline. The operation will be conducted in three phases.

 - (2) Phase 2. The establishment of FSPB CORAL and the deployment of 1 RAR and 3 RAR into their blocking positions in the period 12 - 13 May.
 - (3) Phase 3. The deployment of A Bty, 2/35 (US) Arty, HQ 1 ATF (FWd) and TFMA into FSPB CORAL on 13 May.

ANNEX A TO 1 ATF FRAG NO 5 TO OPO NO 19/68 DATHO 10 MAY 68

ENEMY SITUATION AO SURFERS

General.

- 1. Since the start of the third enemy offensive on 4 May 68 it has become apparent that substantial enemy mainforce and local force units have either passed through AO SURFERS, or can be expected to do so in the near future. Enemy units moving South or SW through the area can be expected to be tactically deployed moving as units or sub-units under a coordinated command structure and to possess high morale. Conversely it can also be expected that enemy elements moving North or NW, away from the heavy fighting near SAIGON, will be moving in small groups, may be disorganized or even lost, and their morale will be low. One point worth remembering is that large enemy groups will be moving fast, probably on trails, and may often extend beyond our normal killing zones in ambushes.
- 2. A trace of main enemy base camps already located by US/ARVN forces, together with the general direction of enemy movement patterns is attached as annex 0.
- 3. <u>Enougy Identification</u>. It has already been ascertained both from PW and captured documents that elements of the following enougy regiments have already been contacted in or near AO SURFERS:
 - a. 141 NVA Regt. (Str now 975).
 - b. 165 NVA Regt. (Str now 694).
 - o. 274 VC Regt. (Str now 720).
 - 275 VC Regt. (Str ?).
 - e. DONG NAI Regt. (Str new 8 900).
 ODBAT-Charts of these regts are attached.

- 4. In addition the following LF or district elements are also operating in or near AC SURFERS:

 - 83 Rear Services Group. (Str 900).

Enemy Weapons.

- 5. Local force enemy units are equipped with the usual types of small arms and automatic weapons, but in addition they do possess and have recently employed, 81/82 mm mors. Harassing fires can be expected. Enemy 122 mm rocket sites have been sited to the South of AO SURFERS, firing on EIEN HOA and LONG RIMH.
- 6. It has been reported by HQ II FFV that the village of BINH MY (XT9036 XT9132) has become an important VC troop staging area and supply depot. There have been many indications that VC units, moving South staged through BINH MY and that some of them have returned there to regroup after recent heavy fighting in and around SAIGON. This village is a logical choice for a staging area since it is located at the edge of forest and rubber plantations.

To the South is a relatively open area with little cover from visual and photo recommaissence which would have to be travelled at night by VC/NVA forces. The village is the last place where troops can rest before a long night's march South; it is in close proximity to several suitable routes for swift travel South; and it has VC guides who can lead troops who are unfamiliar with the area.
